## About the ARMSU Resource Centre

The ARMSU Resource Centre is a specialised collection designed to support the inclusion and well-being of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and families in child care and education.

We aim to build a collection which is:

- comprehensive
- inclusive and balanced
- current and evolving
- reflective of diverse Indigenous cultures and peoples
- culturally relevant and sensitive

Resources for children include picture books, big books, stories, puppets, kits, videos, DVDs, CDs, multi sensory toys, persona dolls, games and puzzles.

Resources for child care professionals and teachers include programming and curriculum resources, reference materials, biographies, music, and other publications to support cultural awareness and the growth of understanding of the principles of cultural security.

ARMSU Resource Centre staff can provide culturally appropriate advice, information and support on the inclusion of Indigenous perspectives in programs, practices and policies. We can also advise on how to find and appropriately assess Indigenous resources for selection or purchasing.

The ARMSU Resource Centre is part funded by the Professional Support Coordinator (PSC) Gowrie Training Centre under the Australian Government's Inclusion and Professional Support Program (IPSP).

Under this program, certain categories of membership are subsidised (see opposite). Subsidised memberships include membership of Lady Gowrie Resource Centre SA.

## Annual Membership Fees

Memberships are for a 1 year period from the joining date

**Subsidised Memberships** (Funded through the Australian Government's Inclusion and Professional Support Program. Includes free membership of the Lady Gowrie Resource Centre SA and free courier/postage of loans and returns).

**Individual Family Day Carers**  
**\$27.50**

3 items per card holder may be borrowed.

**Individuals working in CCB Approved Services**  
**\$55.00**

6 items per card holder may be borrowed. Evidence of current employment in a child care service is required.

**CCB Approved Services Membership**  
**\$110.00**

Up to 4 borrowers and 12 items per centre may be borrowed at one time. Includes all CCB approved child care, OSHC and integrated services.

**Full Rate Memberships** (Not eligible for reciprocal Lady Gowrie Resource Centre SA membership. Membership fee includes free postage / courier delivery and return for up to 8 loans per year.)

**Students**  
**\$55.00**

Student ID required. 6 items per card holder may be borrowed.

**Individuals (non-Child Care)**  
**\$110.00**

6 items per card holder may be borrowed

**Organisations**  
**\$150.00**

Up to 4 borrowers and 12 items per location may be borrowed at one time. Includes preschools and schools, TAFES, FDC District Offices and local government agencies.

## Entitlements & Conditions

- Items may be borrowed for up to 6 weeks.
- Up to 3 DVDs or videos may be borrowed per membership/centre at one time.
- Renewal for one loan period is available if items are not reserved.
- Costs for postage or courier of resources within South Australia are determined by your membership eligibility (see membership details overleaf).
- Cards must be presented or barcode quoted when borrowing items. Proof of ID may be required.
- All items are to be returned or renewed by due date.
- Overdue items will incur a fine of \$5.00 per week per item. Missing/damaged items will incur a replacement charge.
- Borrowing rights are suspended until all fines are paid.
- The card owner is responsible for all items borrowed on its authority and any resulting fines.
- Members who are eligible for the joint ARMSU and Lady Gowrie Resource Centre SA membership must also agree to the terms and conditions of the Lady Gowrie Resource Centre SA before borrowing from the Lady Gowrie resource collection.
- It is the member's responsibility to be aware of the terms and conditions above.
